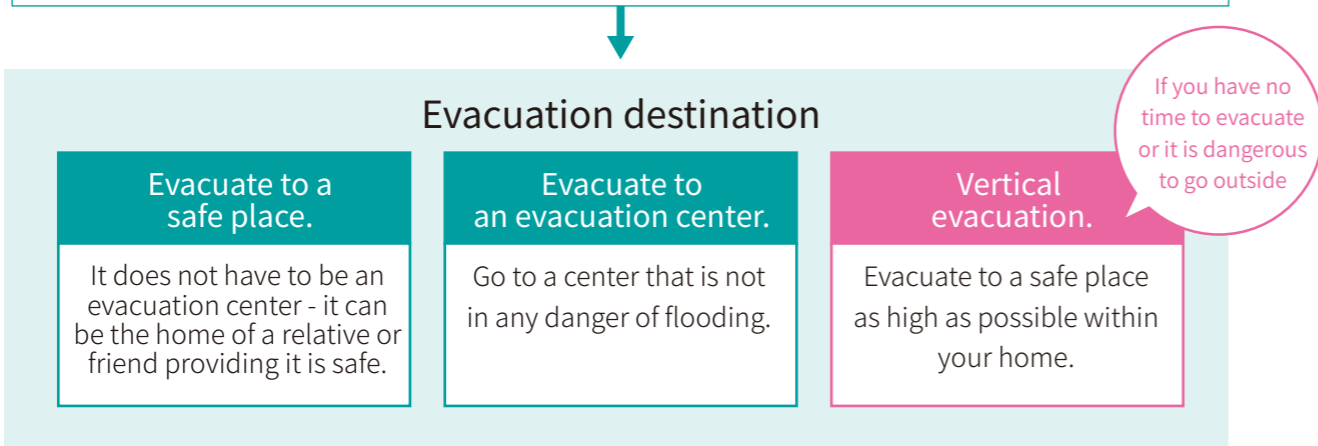
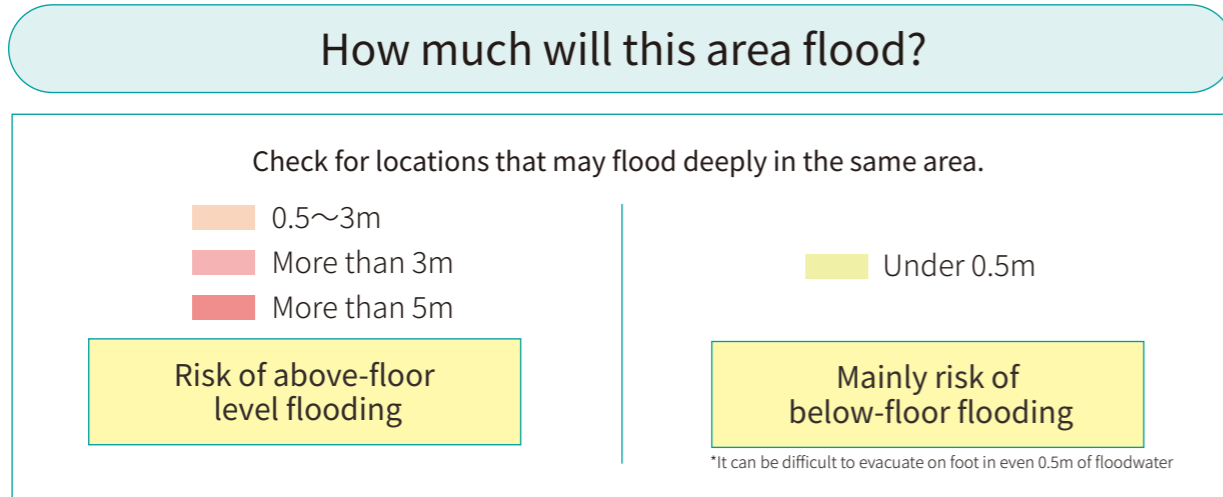
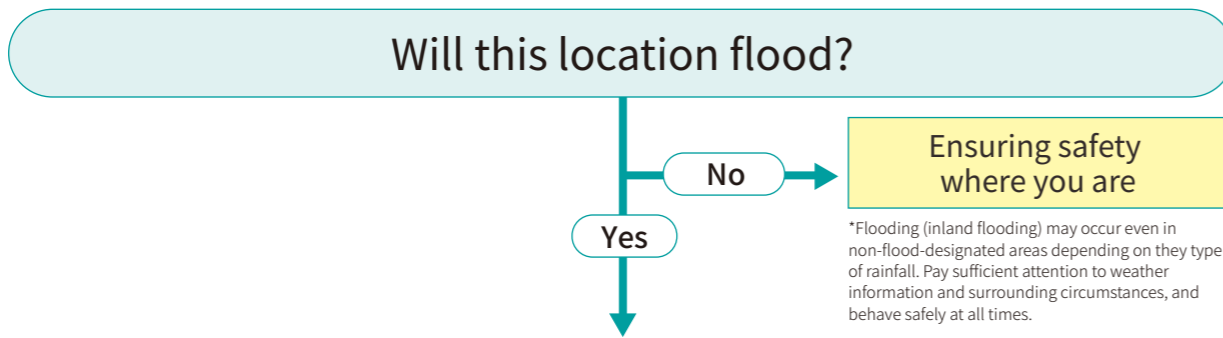


Step 1 Know the dangers of high tides

Please check your locations on the detailed map (P13~22)

※Your locations may include not only your home, but also your workplace, school, relatives' homes etc.



Think of several places to which you can walk to escape.



Step 2 How to determine which evacuation site to use and ensure a safe evacuation route

Check the destination you thought of in Step 1.

Check how safe it is to evacuate to this destination.
If even one of these applies, consider a different evacuation destination.

Check all items!

Check sheet

- Are there any larger rivers or other waterways on the route?
- Are there any deep-flooding (0.5m or higher) places on the route?
- Are there any areas at risk of landslides?
