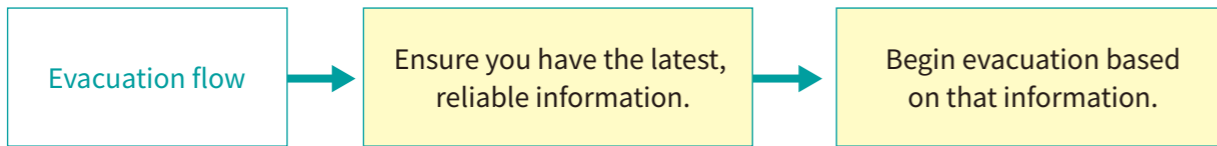


Step 3 How to determine when is the correct time to evacuate



During a disaster, ensure you have the latest information, based on "How to Gather Information" (Chapter 2) and use this information to help you evacuate safely. A disaster may occur even before information is issued by the authorities. Pay attention to weather information and the surrounding circumstances, and move yourself to safety as soon as you sense danger.

Information on high tides and how to preserve life

Disaster information		How to protect yourself and others
Danger level 1	Issued by the Meteorological Agency Early warning information	Prepare for a disaster Pay attention to weather information
Danger level 2	Issued by the Meteorological Agency High tide advisory	Confirm evacuation procedure <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Reconfirm your evacuation route on the hazard map Pay attention to weather information
Danger level 3	Issued by Handa City Evacuation of elderly residents etc.	In case of evacuating elderly residents etc. (people who require time to evacuate) or to an evacuation center that requires time to reach <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Move to a safer place such as a relative or friend's house (could be outside the city) Move to an evacuation center that has been opened Recheck your disaster preparations (luggage) in advance of an instruction to evacuate Pay attention to water level information
Equivalent to Danger Level 3	Issued by the Ministry of Land, Infrastructure and Transport, the Meteorological Agency and Aichi Prefecture High tide advisory	
Danger level 4	Issued by Handa City Handa City will issue an order to evacuate.	Everyone in the area where a warning is issued must evacuate If you sense danger during evacuation, move immediately to a nearby safe place. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Move to a safer place such as a relative or friend's house (could be outside the city) Move to an evacuation center that has been opened
Equivalent to Danger Level 4	Issued by the Ministry of Land, Infrastructure and Transport, the Meteorological Agency and Aichi Prefecture High tide warning/ Special high tide warning	
Danger level 5	Where possible, issued by Handa City Ensure safety immediately It is extremely possible that some sort of disaster may already have occurred.	Take action to protect life Your life may be in danger. Ensure your safety as soon as possible. You may not be able to evacuate safely and your life may be in danger. Move immediately to a place safer than the one you are currently in.
Equivalent to Danger Level 5	Issued by the Ministry of Land, Infrastructure and Transport, the Meteorological Agency and Aichi Prefecture Information regarding river bursts due to high tide
