

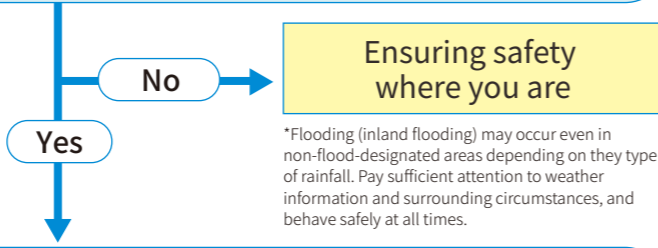

Please check your locations on the detailed map (P31~56)

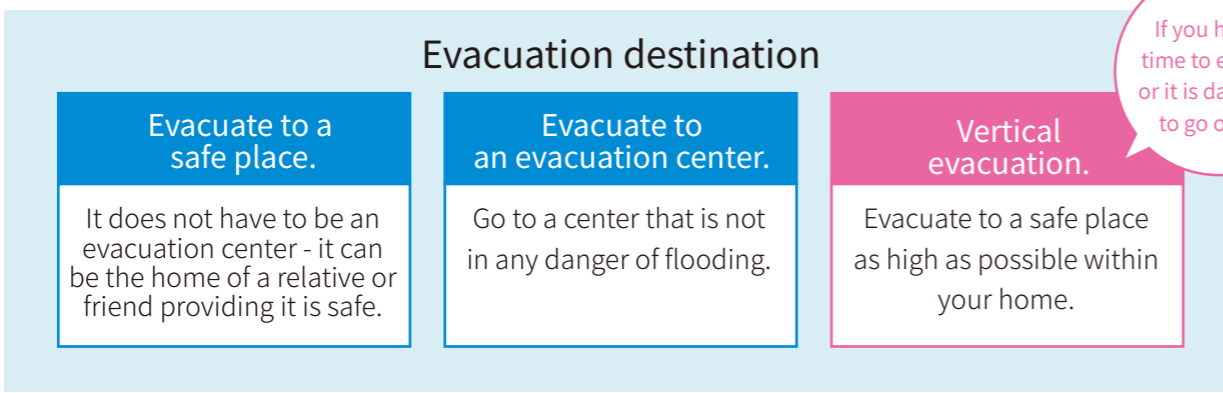
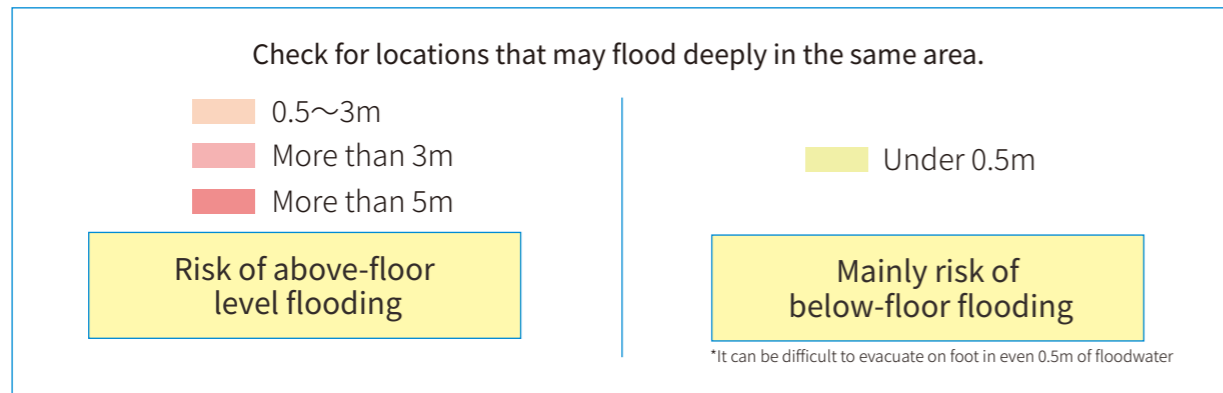
※Your locations may include not only your home, but also your workplace, school, relatives' homes etc.

*Flooding (inland flooding) may occur even in non-flood-designated areas depending on they type of rainfall. Pay sufficient attention to weather information and surrounding circumstances, and behave safely at all times.

How to determine which evacuation site to use and ensure a safe evacuation route

Check the destination you thought of in Step 1.

Check how safe it is to evacuate to this destination.
If even one of these applies, consider a different evacuation destination.

Check all items!

Check sheet

- Are there any larger rivers or other waterways on the route?
- Are there any deep-flooding (0.5m or higher) places on the route?
- Are there any areas at risk of landslides?
