What is Handa city...?

Handa has prospered since long ago in the marine shipping and brewing industries.

Its history is can be seen alive all around its towns.

31 splendid "floats(called Dashi)", tasteful "warehouses" along the Handa waterway, "Niimi Nankichi", known for the fairy tale "Gon, the Fox", and "Handa Red Brick Building", which is a living vestige of the Meiji era.

Wherever you look there are genuine historical and cultural artifacts.

We will continue brewing lots of treats in the future.



Spring Dashi festival

Held in 10 districts through out the city from late March to May 3/4, a total of 31 festival cars appear one after another.

Warehouses and waterway

The area along the Handa waterway is a spot for a stroll where you can see the vestiges of Edo with rows of brewing warehouses enclosed with black wooden walls. You can feel the transition of the seasons along with the sea breeze.



Inside, there is a replica of the 20 meters long "Bezaisen", a ship which was active during the Edo period.

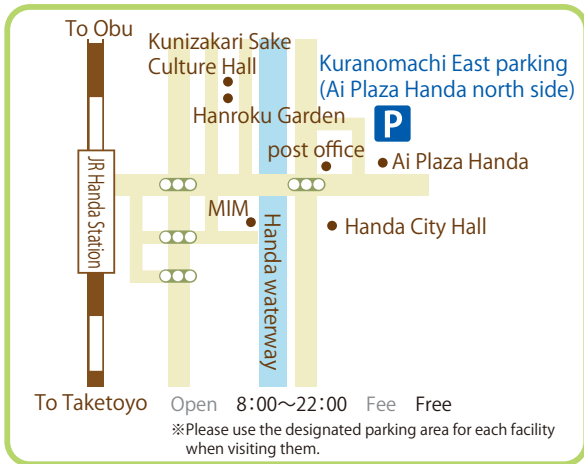

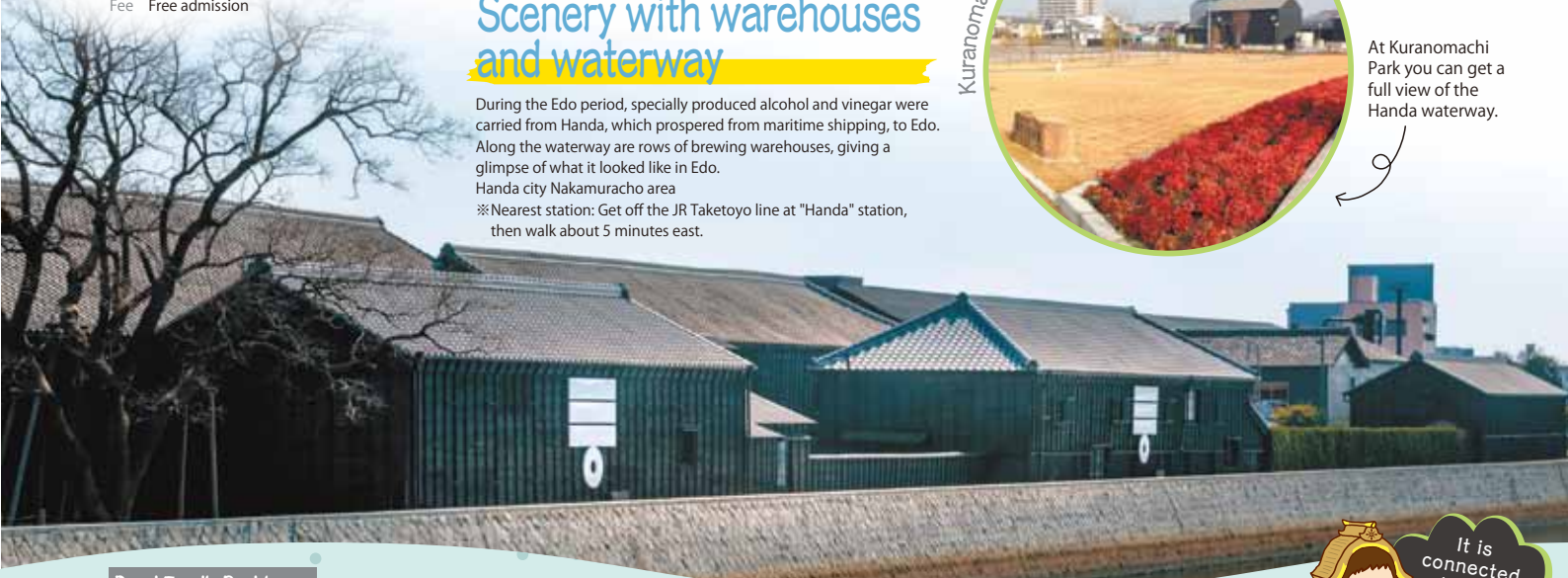
Scenery with warehouses and waterway

During the Edo period, specially produced alcohol and vinegar were carried from Handa, which prospered from maritime shipping, to Edo. Along the waterway are rows of brewing warehouses, giving a glimpse of what it looked like in Edo. Handa city Nakamuracho area

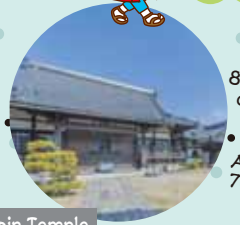

Created in 1898 as the manufacturing factory of Kabuto Beer. It is among the five largest brick structures built in the Meiji era in Japan. It is an especially precious structure because very few beer factories made of bricks still exist. You can still feel the determined entrepreneurial spirit which challenged the major beer makers from a provincial town in the early days of Japanese beer history.

An authentic German beer that won the gold medal at the 1900 Paris World Exposition. Reproduced based on the recipe from the Meiji era.

In this magical and relaxed space surrounded by red bricks, you can enjoy restored draft Kabuto Beer and delicious snacks made from local ingredients. At the shop you can also buy souvenirs and bottled Kabuto Beer.

The surface of the wall on the northern side of the building has the untouched marks of machinegun fire received during the World War II.



The walls of the building are multi-wall structures with 2-5 layers of air in order to maintain the temperature and moisture required for beer production.

Niimi Nankichi (1913~1943)

新美南吉

A children's writer who is known as the author of the fairy tales "Gon the Fox", "Going to Buy Gloves", and "sorrow of a snail".

Born July 30, 1913 in the town of Handa (currently Handa city) in Chita District, Aichi Prefecture. Losing his mother at a young age, he was put up for adoption and led a lonely life as a child. He continued writing while working as a teacher, and died of tuberculosis at the age of 29 on March 22, 1943.



Niimi Nankichi Memorial Museum

A memorial literary museum which houses handwritten manuscripts, correspondence, etc. of Niimi Nankichi. It is built on the ground which was the stage for "Gon the Fox". In the fairy tale forest, there is a walking route where you can observe the plants that appear in the story.

Events are held at Nankichi village year round.

- Kaigaraki (anniversary of Nankichi's death) **March 22**
Host an event in remembrance of Nankichi.
- Nankichi's Firefly Festival **Late June**
Fireflies take off in the air like a scene from Nankichi's fairy tale "Tree Festival".
- Nankichi's Day (Nankichi's Birthday) **July 30**
Host an event celebrating the birth of Nankichi.
- Gon Fall Festival **Late September to Early October**
Like a scene from "Gon, the Fox (Gongitsune)", on the banks of Yakachi River there are over 3 million red spider lilies blooming.

The bank of the Yakachi River, where Nankichi often took walks. In the fall there are over 3 million red spider lilies blooming over 1.5km from east to west. Nearby field mustard and cosmos flowers bloom, beautifully decorating the village of Nankichi's fairy tales over the four seasons.

Located in the north of Handa city, the old streets are still alive in the Kamezaki district, including the JR Taketoyo line running on the oldest route in Aichi prefecture, hilly roads from which you can see the sea, and for Dashi car warehouses.

Because Handa and the rest of Chita Peninsula is blessed with quality underground water and a warm climate, it brewing industry has prospered since the Edo period.

Alcohol, vinegar, miso and tamari are produced here, with the traditional tastes and techniques passed down. Now in Handa there are efforts to develop food and souvenirs based on the keyword of "Kamosu (brew)".

Looking for the roots of "brewing"!

Handa vinegar brewing tools

Tools which were used to brew vinegar by the Nakano family in their vinegar business from the Edo Period. In March 2016 the vinegar brewing tools were designated as national important tangible folk-cultural properties, a first in Japan. You can see them in the Handa Municipal Museum.
