## Please Follow the Rules for Waste Disposal

- Put it out by 8:00 a.m. on the collection day.
- Always separate recyclables from other waste.
- Don't put it out anywhere other than your designated waste collection station.
- Tie the bags closed.
- Thoroughly drain off any liquid from food scraps.
- Put a net securely over the waste.

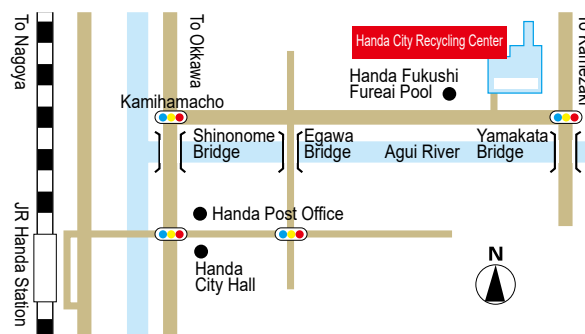

Two-thirds of the purchase price is subsidized, so you can buy it at a great price.

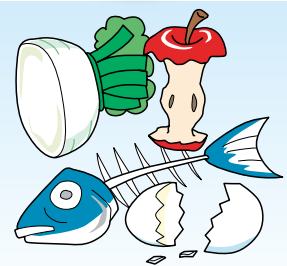

# Burnable Waste

Use the Handa City designated waste bags (green) for putting out your waste.



Food scraps

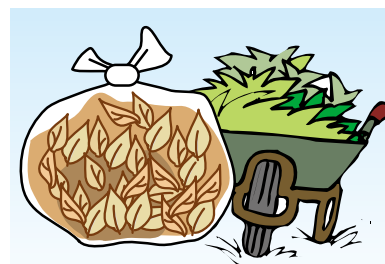

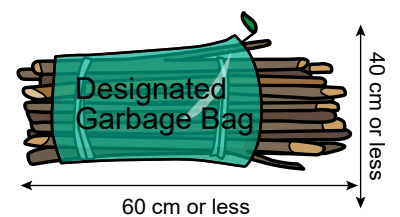

## ● How to put out branch cuttings (diameter of less than 5 cm) and bamboo

See p. 11 for details.



They must be at most 60 cm in length and at most 40 cm in width. Wrap a large designated garbage bag (burnable waste) around them, and tie them up with string.

## ● How to put out futons and blankets

Wrap futons and blankets in designated garbage bags



Fold each futon separately, wrap a large designated garbage bag (burnable waste) around it, and tie it up with string.

## ● Putting out paper diapers for collection

Put paper diapers in a transparent or semitransparent bag, which is not designated a waste bag, then write "おむつ" (diapers) on the bag with a pen so the contents are declared, before taking it to the waste collection station. Newspapers used for wrapping diapers can also be put out together.

\* Bringing disposable diapers directly to the Chita Nambu Koiki Kankyo Center costs 100 yen per 10 kg.



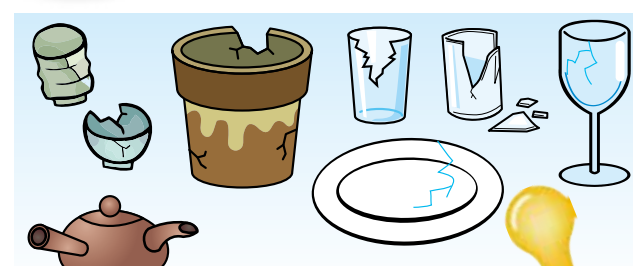
## Points for waste disposal and reduction

- **Never put lithium-ion batteries out. Accidental collection of them can result in a fire in the garbage trucks and disposal facilities.** See p. 12 for details.
- **Grass clippings, branch cuttings and bamboo may be taken into the Recycling Center as resources, free of charge.** See p. 10 for details.
- Thoroughly drain off any liquid from food scraps.
- Minimize food loss by using up ingredients, eating up all your food, etc.
- Use waste disposers and composting bins to reduce food scraps. There's a subsidy scheme for buying these items. See p. 2 for details.

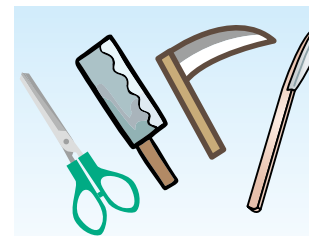

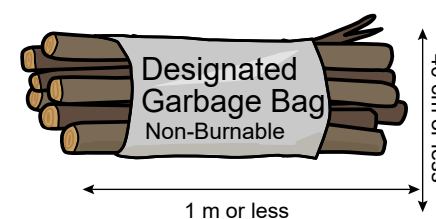

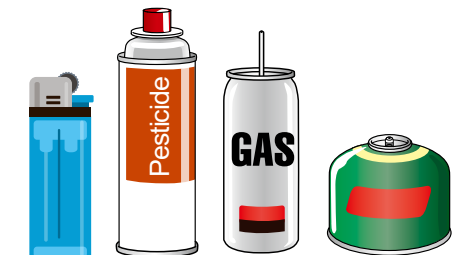

## ● How to put out branch cuttings (diameter of 5 cm or more and less than 20 cm)



They must be at most 1 m in length and at most 40 cm in width. Wrap a large designated garbage bag (non-burnable waste) around them, and tie them up with string.

## What is Flammable Hazardous Waste?



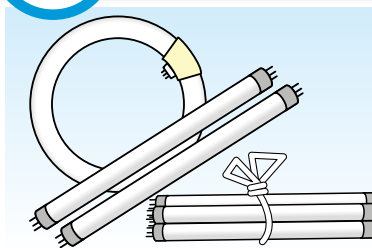
Waste that's flammable, such as cassette gas cylinders, spray cans, and disposable lighters

### How to Correctly Put Out Flammable Hazardous Waste

Use up all the contents, but don't punch holes in the containers. Put them in a transparent or semitransparent bag, stick a **Flammable Hazardous Waste Separation Sticker** on it, and put it out on the collection day for non-burnable waste.

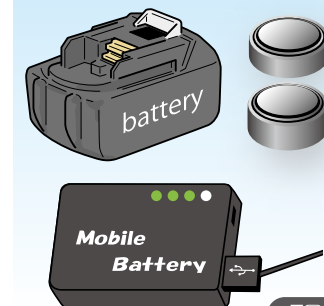
\* You can use a bag that is not a designated garbage bag.  
\* Please refer to the city's website for more information on how to obtain a Flammable Hazardous Waste Separation Sticker, etc.

## ✗ Items You Can't Put Out



Fluorescent tubes contain mercury, so please take them directly to the **Recycling Center, without breaking them.**

\* LED fluorescent tubes and broken fluorescent tubes can be taken to the Waste Collection Station as non-burnable waste.

• Button cell batteries  
They're collected at cooperating stores that provide recycling services, such as home appliances stores and home improvement centers. Button cell batteries are collected at cooperating stores that provide collection services.

## Points for waste disposal and reduction

- **Never put lithium-ion batteries out. Accidental collection of them can result in a fire in the garbage trucks and disposal facilities.** See p. 12 for details.
- **Separate cans and bottles as valuable resources.** See p. 7 for details.
- **Batteries and electrically powered items are collected separately as small home appliances.** See p. 9 for details.
- Metals can be brought to the Recycling Center free of charge as recyclables. See p. 11 for details.

Items You Can't Put Out

Such plastic products as toys, buckets, plastic food storage containers, clothes hangers and the like, are handled as burnable waste, when put out at the waste collection station.

Remove the caps and labels, and rinse the inside lightly. Put out the caps and labels as plastic containers and packaging. PET plastic bottle caps are also collected at public facilities, etc.

# Cans, bottles, used clothes and used paper

Empty cans, empty bottles, used clothes, newspapers, corrugated cardboards, paper cartons and magazines.

Put out cans, bottles, used clothes and the like, in the manner described below.

- How to put them out**

**1**

**Put them out for group recycling collection.**

Civic groups such as community associations and children's associations collect items for recycling. Please check with your local community association to find out when and where the recyclables are collected.

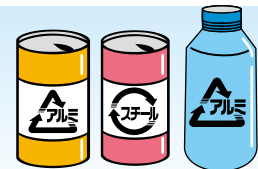
## <Drink cans>



■ Cans with an aluminum or steel can mark

### How to put them out

- Remove the cap and rinse them lightly.
- When putting out bottle-shaped cans, remove the caps first to prevent accidents when they get compacted.
- Don't crush cans.
- Separate aluminum cans from steel ones.



**Caution** Please put out the following items on the days designated for non-burnable waste

- ◆ Cans that still have contents
- ◆ Cans that contain foreign matter
- ◆ Cans with grease and grime that cannot be removed
- ◆ Oil and paint cans (These present problems for recycling if they are made of steel)

## <Cans for food (such aluminum and steel cans)>

■ Cans for food, nori seaweed, sweets, tea, cooking oil, pet food, milk, etc.

**How to put them out** • Empty the contents and lightly rinse before putting them out. Lids may also be put out together.



■ Glass bottles for beverages, food, and cosmetics

### How to put them out

- Remove the cap and rinse them lightly.
- Separate them by color. (1. White/colorless, 2. Brown, 3. Other.)

\* Caps removed are Non-burnable waste.



**Caution** Please put out the following items on the days designated for non-burnable waste

- ◆ Bottles for drugs and chemicals
- ◆ Microwavable heat-resistant glass
- ◆ Glass dishes
- ◆ Sheet glass
- ◆ Milky-white glass bottles

■ Clothes that can still be worn, towels, sheets, etc.



**Caution** Please put out the following items on the days designated for non-burnable waste

- ◆ Contaminated items
- ◆ Smelly items
- ◆ Wet items
- ◆ Scrap fabric

**Wash them before putting them out.**

## Used Paper

### ■ Newspaper



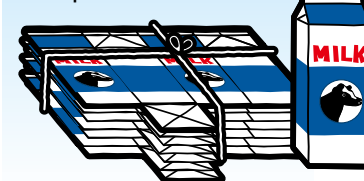
- Tie it up with string before putting it out.

### ■ Corrugated cardboard



- This means cardboard that has a wavy layer in the middle. Remove any tape or delivery slips from them and tie them up with string before putting them out.

### ■ Paper cartons



- Rinse them lightly, open them out, and tie them up with string before putting them out. You can't put out paper cartons that are silver on the inside.

### ■ Other recyclable paper



- Tie up magazines, comic books, picture books, copier paper, etc. with string before putting them out.



These items must not be put out as used paper!

Please put these out on the days designated for burnable waste

### Adhesive materials

- ◆ Adhesive tapes
- ◆ Stickers

### ◆ Vinyl-coated papers

Please put out these items on the days designated for paper containers and packaging

- ◆ Waxed paper products, such as paper cups
- ◆ Oiled papers
- ◆ Photographs
- ◆ Synthetic papers
- ◆ Thermal papers

# Grass Clippings and Branch Cuttings

The amount of burnable waste can be reduced by taking grass clippings and branch cuttings (including bamboo), which are generated by households, into the Recycling Center as recyclables (recycled into compost and chips).

## How to bring grass clippings and branch cuttings

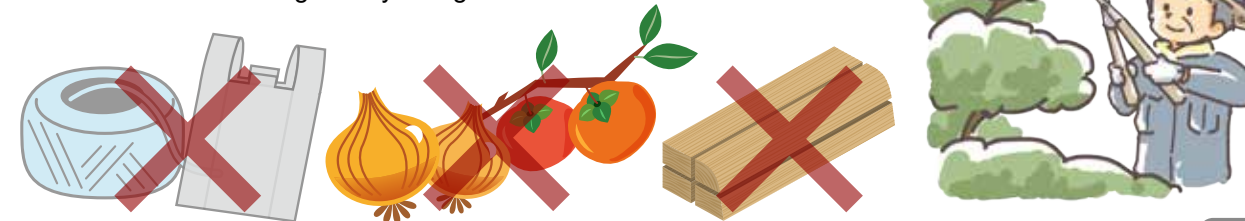
You'll need to unload your waste yourself. When unloading it, separate grass clippings from branch cuttings, and remove any bindings and bags. Separate them before you bring them, to make unloading easier.

## Acceptable size for bringing grass clippings and branch cuttings

The maximum size permitted for branch cuttings is about 2 m in length and 40 cm in diameter. Remove the soil from the grass clippings as much as possible.

### Note

- Your waste can't be recycled if there are other items mixed in with it, such as strings and vinyl. Please cooperate by separating your waste thoroughly.
- Grass clippings and branch cuttings put out at the Waste Collection Station are not recycled. Please cooperate by bringing them into the Recycling Center.
- Vegetable waste, etc. is not subject to recycling, so please dispose of it as burnable waste.
- Timber can't be put out as branch cuttings.
- We ask for your cooperation in confirming that it is not business-related waste when it is brought in by a large vehicle.

# Metals, hard plastic products and wooden fixtures

How to put them out  
**1**

**Take directly into the Recycling Center (free of charge)**

If you bring the following items to the Recycling Center, they will be treated as recyclables and can be put out free of charge.

## Metals

Metal products, or things that are mostly made of metal. Spring mattresses and bicycles can be brought in as is without disassembling.

<Specific examples>

Tools (screwdrivers, bars, jacks, and hammers), blades and ironware (pots, pans, kettles, cooking knives, knives, steel plates, cookers, etc.), and others (scissors and steel furniture)

\* Please cover the blades.

\* Please put it out as non-burnable waste if putting it out at the Waste Collection Station.

**Items that may be put out (examples)**



**Items that may not be put out**

- ◆ Contaminated items
- ◆ Items containing a large proportion of different materials
- ◆ Fire resistant safes
- ◆ Metal baseball bats

## Hard plastic products

Hard plastic products that bear no recyclable plastic mark and are about the thickness of a cash card are eligible.

Items that contain materials other than plastic are not eligible. They may be taken in if such different materials are removed.

<Specific examples>

Wardrobes, buckets, laundry baskets, clothes hangers, pails, watering cans, bowls, sieves, toys, CD case

\* Please put it out as a burnable waste if putting it out at the Waste Collection Station.

**Items that may be put out (examples)**



**Items that may not be put out**

- ◆ Contaminated items
- ◆ Items that contain materials other than plastic.
- ◆ Items that operate with electricity or batteries are considered small home appliances
- ◆ CDs, DVDs and Blu-ray discs
- ◆ Those made of PVC- and resin-based materials

## Wooden fixtures

Furnitures made of wood are eligible.

**Please remove all other materials, such as glass, cloth and paper.** Nails and screws, however, do not need to be removed.

# Large Bulky Items

## Large bulky items include the following:

- Items that don't fit in a designated bag or that are more than 60 cm in length, width, or height.
- Items that could cause a fire or explosion, such as kerosene stoves and kerosene fan heaters.



You can't put them out in the waste collection station. Dispose of them as follows:

### How to put them out 1

## Bring it directly to the Chita Nambu Koiki Kankyo Center. (Fees will apply.)

- The Chita Nambu Koiki Kankyo Center can't dispose of items that are 2 m or more in length, width, or height.
- Please take items that can be recycled as recyclables, such as wooden furniture or bicycles, to the Recycling Center.

- Purchase a "Sodaigomi Shoriken", a large bulky item disposal ticket, at a retailer. **No refunds are available for Sodaigomi Shoriken.** Please purchase only as many as you need.
- Put the items in front of the entrance at your residence by 8:30 AM on the booked date. You do not need to be present for collection.

\* Our staff will not be able to come into your residence for collections.

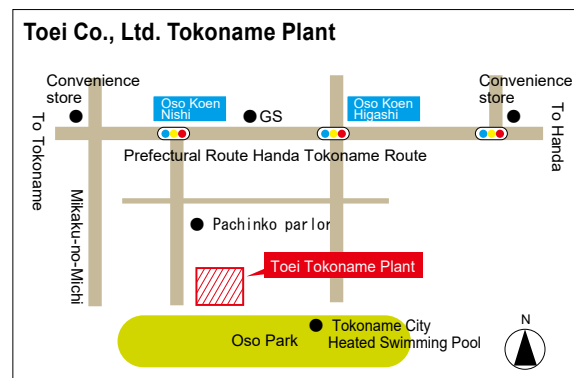

The following items cannot be disposed of as garbage, so please ask the retailer, etc. to dispose of them.

### When You're Not Sure Which Category to Separate Something into

- Did it come from a household?**  
Waste from businesses can't be put out at the waste collection station.  
Dispose of it via an industrial waste disposal company, etc.
- Is it not classified as difficult to dispose of?**  
The city doesn't handle items that are difficult to dispose of, such as soil, sand, concrete blocks, bricks, and tires. Please contact a specialized disposal company. [☎ See p. 16 for details.](#)
- Is it not covered by recycling of home appliances?**  
TVs, air conditioners, refrigerators and freezers, and washing machines and dryers must be disposed of by the designated methods. [☎ See p. 15 for details.](#)
- Can it be put out for community recycling collection or as recyclables?**  
Please cooperate with recycling and reducing waste.
- Will it fit into a designated garbage bag?**  
Things are categorized as large bulky items if they're more than 60 cm in length, width, or height, and the bag can't be tied closed with them in it.
- Check the main materials.**  
If it's made of several materials, break it up as much as possible, then put out the pieces according to their own categories.  
If you can't break it up, decide what to do with it based on which material it's mostly made of.
