# Broadening the area for waste treatment

Changing from April 1, 2022

## <Information on broadening the area for waste treatment>

Waste produced in Handa City in the past was treated at the Handa City Clean Center, but starting from 2022 waste will be treated jointly by two cities and three towns (Handa City, Tokoname City, Minamichita Town, Mihama Town and Taketoyo Town). This new waste treatment facility was established as Chita Nanbu Koiki Kankyo Center (Chita Southern Broad Area Environment Center) (Nicknamed “Yumekurin” (Dream Cleanliness) in Taketoyo Town. Cost reductions and reductions to the environmental burden can be expected by jointly treating waste materials.

## < Method for using the waste collection station is the same as before>

No changes have been made as to how the waste collection station is used. You will be able to continue using the service as in the past. Due to the changes in the waste treatment facility, however, **the classification for hard plastic products (such as buckets and pails, etc.) at the waste collection station will change from “non-burnable waste” to “burnable waste”.**

## <Handa City “Clean Center” will become the “Recycling Center”>

<Since the Handa City Clean Center will no longer treat waste, its name will be changed to the “City Recycling Center”> Please continue using the facility as a location for taking in recyclables from households.

## <A portion of the facilities designated for taking in waste and recyclables will be changed>



Since the start of 2022, metals, hard plastic products and wooden furniture are recycled as resources at Handa City, they may be taken into the Handa City Recycling Center free of charge.

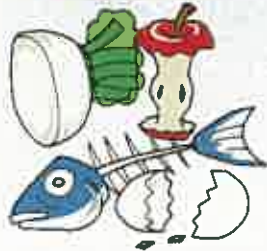

# Burnable Waste

Use the Handa City designated waste bags (green) for putting out your waste.

## How to put out branch cuttings (diameter of less than 5 cm) and bamboo



They must be at most 60 cm in length and at most 40 cm in width. Wrap a large designated garbage bag (burnable waste) around them, and tie them up with string.

## How to put out futons and blankets

Wrap futons and blankets in designated garbage bags



Fold each futon separately, wrap a large designated garbage bag (burnable waste) around it, and tie it up with string.

## Putting out paper diapers for collection

Put paper diapers in a transparent or semitransparent bag, which is not designated a waste bag, then write "おむつ" (diapers) on the bag with a pen so the contents are declared, before taking it to the waste collection station. Newspapers used for wrapping diapers can also be put out together.

\* Directly take the items to the Chita Nanbu Koiki Kankyo Center (Chita Southern Broad Area Environment Center) costs 100 yen per 10 kg.



## Tips for Reducing Waste

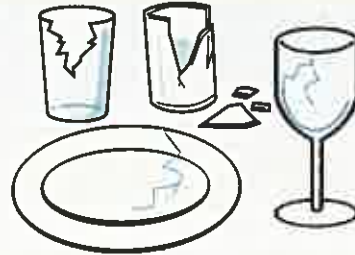
- Put out paper items on the collection day for "Paper Containers and Packaging / Other Recyclable Paper." [See p. 5 for details](#)
- Grass clippings, branch cuttings and bamboo may be taken into the Recycling Center as resources, free of charge. [See p. 10 for details](#)
- Thoroughly drain off any liquid from food scraps.
- Minimize food loss by using up ingredients, eating up all your food, etc.
- Use waste disposers and composting bins to reduce food scraps. There's a subsidy scheme for buying these items. [See p. 18 for details](#)

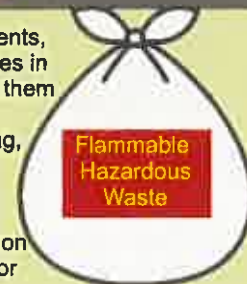

## How to put out branch cuttings (diameter of 5 cm or more and less than 20 cm)



## Caution How to Correctly Put Out Flammable Hazardous Waste

Use up all the contents, but don't punch holes in the containers. Put them in a transparent or semitransparent bag, stick a **Flammable Hazardous Waste Separation Slicker** on it, and put it out on the collection day for non-burnable waste.



\* Waste can also be put out in non-designated bags.

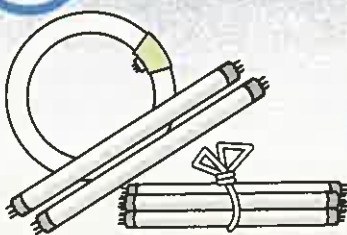
### What is Flammable Hazardous Waste?



Waste that's flammable, such as cassette gas cylinders, spray cans, and disposable lighters



## Items You Can't Put Out



Fluorescent tubes contain **mercury**, so please take them directly to **the Recycling Center, without breaking them.**

\* LED fluorescent tubes do not contain mercury, so they can be put out as non-burnable waste in the waste collection station.

## Tips for Reducing Waste

- **Separate the cans from the bottles and do not put them out as waste.** See p. 7 for details.
- **Separate batteries and products that operate with a power supply, before putting them out as "small home appliances" for collection.** See p. 9 for details.
- **Items that are too large to fit in a designated bag must not be put into the waste collection station.**
- **Metals may be brought into the Recycling Center as recyclables, free of charge.**

# Plastic Containers and Packaging

Put them out in Handa City's designated recycling collection bags (white).



## Items You Can Put Out (Examples)

Plastic "containers" and "packaging" that contained products are eligible. Empty the contents and lightly wash before putting them out.

Examples: Cups and packaging, tubes, lids, labels on PET bottles, bottles, trays, styrene foam containers and packing materials.



## Items You Can't Put Out

Such plastic products as toys, buckets, plastic food storage containers, clothes hangers and the like, are handled as burnable waste, when put out at the waste collection station.

Hard plastic products can be recycled as recyclables, by directly taking them into the Recycling Center.

# PET Plastic Bottles

Put them out in Handa City's designated recycling collection bags (white).



## Items You Can Put Out

Remove the caps and labels, and rinse the inside lightly. Put out the caps and labels as plastic containers and packaging. PET plastic bottle caps are also collected at public facilities, etc.

## <How to put out PET plastic bottles>



(1) Remove the cap.

(2) Remove the label.

(3) Rinse them lightly.



# Cans, bottles, used clothes and used paper

Empty cans, empty bottles, used clothes, newspapers, corrugated cardboards, paper cartons and magazines

Put out cans, bottles, used clothes and the like, in the manner described below.

### Empty Cans

#### <Drink cans>



■ Cans with an aluminum or steel can mark

#### How to put them out

- Remove the cap and rinse them lightly.
- When putting out bottle-shaped cans, remove the caps first to prevent accidents when they get compacted.
- Don't crush cans.
- Separate aluminum cans from steel ones.

#### <Cans for food (such aluminum and steel cans)>

■ Cans for food, nori seaweed, sweets, tea, cooking oil, pet food, milk, etc.



#### How to put them out

- Empty the contents and lightly rinse before putting them out. Lids may also be put out together.

**Caution** Please put out the following items on the days designated for non-burnable waste

- ◆ Cans that still have contents
- ◆ Cans that contain foreign matter
- ◆ Cans with grease and grime that cannot be removed
- ◆ Oil and paint cans (These present problems for recycling if they are made of steel)

### Empty Glass Bottles

■ Glass bottles for beverages, food, and cosmetics

#### How to put them out

- Remove the cap and rinse them lightly.
- Separate them by color. (1. White/colorless, 2. Brown, 3. Other.)



**Caution** Please put out the following items on the days designated for non-burnable waste

- ◆ Bottles for drugs and chemicals
- ◆ Microwavable heat-resistant glass
- ◆ Glass dishes
- ◆ Sheet glass
- ◆ Milky-white glass bottles

### Used Clothes

■ Clothes that can still be worn, towels, sheets, etc.



Wash them before putting them out.

**Caution** Please put out the following items on the days designated for non-burnable waste

- ◆ Contaminated items
- ◆ Smelly items
- ◆ Wet items
- ◆ Scrap fabric



■ Newspaper



- Tie it up with string before putting it out.

■ Corrugated cardboard



- This means cardboard that has a wavy layer in the middle. Remove any tape or delivery slips from them and tie them up with string before putting them out.

■ Paper cartons



- Rinse them lightly, open them out, and tie them up with string before putting them out. You can't put out paper cartons that are silver on the inside.

■ Other recyclable paper



- Tie up magazines, comic books, picture books, copier paper, etc. with string before putting them out.

**Caution** These items must not be put out as used paper!

Please put these out on the days designated for burnable waste

Adhesive materials

- ◆ Adhesive tapes
- ◆ Stickers
- ◆ Vinyl-coated papers

Please put out these items on the days designated for paper containers and packaging

- ◆ Waxed paper products, such as paper cups
- ◆ Oiled papers
- ◆ Photographs
- ◆ Synthetic papers
- ◆ Thermal papers

# Small Home Appliances

Batteries and electrically powered items (except for air conditioners, TVs, refrigerators, washing machines, and clothes dryers)

## Items You Can Put Out (Examples)

Mobile phones, digital cameras, PCs, microwaves, rice cookers, vacuum cleaners, etc.

- When putting out PCs or mobile phones, erase the data from them yourself.
- Remove the batteries before putting them out.



## Items You Can't Put Out

- Air conditioners, TVs, refrigerators, washing machines and clothes dryers

See p. 15 for details.

- Items that are mostly made of cloth or wood, such as electric carpets, electric blankets, wooden speaker boxes and the like. Fluorescent tubes and batteries. Large items, such as massage chairs and organs.

There's no need to fill out a delivery slip, either.

You'll be informed by e-mail when disposal is complete.

# Recycling Grass Clippings and Branch Cuttings

The amount of burnable waste can be reduced by taking grass clippings and branch cuttings (including bamboo), which are generated by households, into the Recycling Center as recyclables (recycled into compost and chips).

## How to bring grass clippings and branch cuttings

You'll need to unload your waste yourself. When unloading it, separate grass clippings from branch cuttings, and remove any bindings and bags. Separate them before you bring them, to make unloading easier.

## Acceptable size for bringing grass clippings and branch cuttings

The maximum size permitted for branch cuttings is 2 m in length. Remove the soil from the grass clippings as much as possible.

### Note

- \* Please take grass clippings and branch cuttings to the Recycle Center, as they will not be recycled as resources if they are put out at the waste collection station.
- \* Vegetable scraps aren't recyclable, so put them out as burnable waste.
- \* Your waste can't be recycled if there are other items mixed in with it, such as empty cans and bottles. Please cooperate by separating your waste thoroughly.
- \* Timber can't be put out as branch cuttings.

# Metals, hard plastic products and wooden fixtures

How to put them out

## Take directly into the Recycling Center (free of charge)

See p. 2 for details.

Recycling of the following items as recyclables commenced in 2022. They will be handled as recyclables if brought into the Recycling Center, where they will be accepted free of charge.

### Metals

Metal products and items made mostly of metals. Spring mattresses and bicycles, however, may be taken in as they are.

<Specific examples>

Tools (screwdrivers, bars, jacks and hammers), blades and ironware (pots, pans, kettles, carving knives, cooking knives, steel plates, cookers, etc.) and others (dumbbells, scissors and steel furniture)

\* Please cover the blades.

Items that may be put out (examples)



Items that may not be put out

- ◆ Contaminated items
- ◆ Items containing a large proportion of different materials
- ◆ Fire resistant safes

### Hard plastic products

Hard plastic products that bear no recyclable plastic mark and are about the thickness of a cash card are eligible.

Items that contain materials other than plastic are not eligible. They may be taken in if such different materials are removed.

<Specific examples>

Wardrobes, buckets, laundry baskets, clothes hangers, palls, watering cans, bowls, sieves, toys, CD case

Items that may be put out (examples)



Items that may not be put out

- ◆ Contaminated items
- ◆ Items that contain materials other than plastic.
- ◆ Items that operate with electricity or batteries are considered small home appliances

- ◆ CDs, DVDs and Blu-ray discs

### Wooden fixtures

Furnitures made of wood are eligible.

Please remove all other materials, such as glass, cloth and paper. Nails and screws, however, do not need to be removed.

<Specific examples>

Chests of drawers, shelves, sideboards, tables, shoe cupboards, bed frames

- ◆ Items that contain materials other than metal, such as glass, cloth or paper

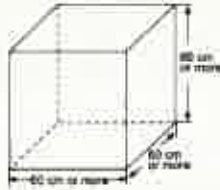

# Large Bulky Items

## Large bulky items include the following:

Items that are more than 60 cm in length, width, or height. Items that could cause a fire or explosion, such as kerosene stoves and kerosene fan heaters.



You can't put them out in the waste collection station. Dispose of them as follows:

- \* Please take items that can be recycled as recyclables, such as wooden furniture or bicycles, to the Recycling Center.

- (1) Call the person in charge of Waste Reduction at the Environment Section (Phone 23-3567).
- (2) Purchase a "Sodaigomi Shoriken", a large bulky item disposal ticket, at a retailer.  
**No refunds are available for Sodaigomi Shoriken.** Please purchase only as many as you need.
- (3) Put the items in front of the entrance at your residence by 8:30 AM on the booked date. You do not need to be present for collection.

\* Our staff will not be able to come into your residence for collections.



## Items You Can't Bring

The following items may not be taken in, as they cannot be processed for treatment by the city.

# Promoting the 3 Rs



The 3R is a general term for Reduce, Reuse and Recycle.

Let us realize a society that reduces waste as much as possible, by effectively utilizing the limited global resources repeatedly as recyclables with the implementation of the 3R activities.

## (1) Reduce waste.

- Take your own shopping bags with you and decline if offered any at the checkout.
- Take your own chopsticks and bottles with you.
- Before you buy something, decide whether you really need it.



## (2) Reuse things.

- Repair and use things that are broken.
- Give things you don't use anymore to people who need them.



## (3) Recycle things as resources.

- Separate recyclables from waste correctly.
- Turn food scraps into compost.
- Buy recycled products.

- You can reuse unwanted furniture, etc. via a community information website.

Handa City concluded an agreement on October 2020 with Jimoty Inc., to promote activities for reuse in the city, to achieve a recycling society with a low environmental impact. New owners, for the unwanted furniture (sofas, beds, shelves, etc.) and bicycles, can be found locally and without paying any fees, by accessing the community information website "Jimoty", managed by the company.

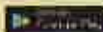

## When You're Not Sure Which Category to Separate Something Into

- **Did it come from a household?**

Waste from businesses can't be put out at the waste collection station. Dispose of it via an industrial waste disposal company, etc.

- **Is it not classified as difficult to dispose of?**

The city doesn't handle items that are difficult to dispose of, such as soil, sand, concrete blocks, bricks, and tires. Please contact a specialized disposal company. See p. 16

- **Is it not covered by recycling of home appliances?**

TVs, air conditioners, refrigerators and freezers, and washing machines and dryers must be disposed of by the designated methods. See p. 15

- **Can it be put out for community recycling collection or as recyclables?**

Please cooperate with recycling and reducing waste.

- **Will it fit into a designated garbage bag?**

Things are categorized as large bulky items if they're more than 60 cm in length, width, or height, and the bag can't be tied closed with them in it.

- **Check the main materials.**

If it's made of several materials, break it up as much as possible, then put out the pieces according to their own categories.

If you can't break it up, decide what to do with it based on which material it's mostly made of.
