- Handa City "Clean Center" will be renamed "Recycling Center" and will become the base for receiving recyclables produced by households.

Broadening the area for waste treatment

Changing from April 1, 2022

<Information on broadening the area for waste treatment>

Waste produced in Handa City in the past was treated at the Handa City Clean Center, but starting from 2022 waste will be treated jointly by two cities and three towns (Handa City, Tokoname City, Minamichita Town, Mihama Town and Taketoyo Town). This new waste treatment facility was established as Chita Nanbu Koiki Kankyo Center (Chita Southern Broad Area Environment Center) (Nicknamed "Yumekurin" (Dream Cleanliness) in Taketoyo Town. Cost reductions and reductions to the environmental burden can be expected by jointly treating waste materials.

< Method for using the waste collection station is the same as before>

No changes have been made as to how the waste collection station is used. You will be able to continue using the service as in the past. Due to the changes in the waste treatment facility, however, the classification for hard plastic products (such as buckets and pails, etc.) at the waste collection station will change from "non-burnable waste" to "burnable waste".

<Handa City "Clean Center" will become the "Recycling Center">

<Since the Handa City Clean Center will no longer treat waste, its name will be changed to the "City Recycling Center"> Please continue using the facility as a location for taking in recyclables from households.

<A portion of the facilities designated for taking in waste and recyclables will be changed>



Since the start of 2022, metals, hard plastic products and wooden furniture are recycled as resources at Handa City, they may be taken into the Handa City Recycling Center free of charge.





How to put out branch cuttings (diameter of less than 5 cm) and bamboo



They must be at most 60 cm in length and at most 40 cm in width.

Wrap a large designated garbage bag (burnable waste) around them, and tie them up with string.

• How to put out futons and blankets

Wrap futons and blankets in designated garbage bags



Fold each futon separately, wrap a large designated garbage bag (burnable waste) around it, and tie it up with string.

• Putting out paper diapers for collection

Put paper diapers in a transparent or semitransparent bag, which is not designated a waste bag, then write "おむつ" (diapers) on the bag with a pen so the contents are declared, before taking it to the waste collection station. Newspapers used for wrapping diapers can also be put out together.

* Directly take the items to the Chita Nanbu Koiki Kankyo Center (Chita Southern Broad Area Environment Center) costs 100 yen per 10 kg.



Tips for Reducing Waste

- Put out paper items on the collection day for "Paper Containers and Packaging / Other Recyclable Paper."
- Grass clippings, branch cuttings and bamboo may be taken into the Recycling Center as resources, free of charge.
- Thoroughly drain off any liquid from food scraps.
- Minimize food loss by using up ingredients, eating up all your food, etc.
- Use waste disposers and composting bins to reduce food scraps.
 There's a subsidy scheme for buying these items.






They must be at most 1 m in length and at most 40 cm in width.

Wrap a large designated garbage bag (non-burnable waste) around them, and tie them up with string.



Use up all the contents, but don't punch holes in the containers. Put them in a transparent or semitransparent bag, stick a Flammable Hazardous Waste Separation Sticker on it, and put it out on the collection day for

non-burnable waste. Waste can also be put out in non-designated bags



Fluorescent tubes contain mercury, so please take them directly to the Recycling Center,

without breaking them.
* LED fluorescent tubes do not contain mercury, so they can be put out as non-burnable waste in the waste collection station.

What is Flammable Hazardous Waste?



Waste that's flammable, such as cassette gas cylinders, spray cans, and disposable lighters

Tips for Reducing Waste

- Separate the cans from the bottles and do not put them out as waste.
- Separate batteries and products that operate with a power supply, before putting them out as "small home appliances" for collection. See p. 9 for details.
- Items that are too large to fit in a designated bag must not be put into the waste collection station.
- · Metals may be brought into the Recycling Center as recyclables, free of charge.

Plastic Containers and Packaging

Items You Can Put Out (Examples)

Plastic "containers" and "packaging" that contained products are eligible. Empty the contents and lightly wash before putting them out.

Examples: Cups and packaging, tubes, lids, labels on PET bottles, bottles, trays, styrene foam containers and packing materials.





Items You Can't

Such plastic products as toys, buckets, plastic food storage containers, clothes hangers and the like, are handled as burnable waste, when put out at the waste collection station.

Batteries and electrically powered items (except for air conditioners, TVs. refrigerators, washing machines, and clothes dryers)

How Recyclables Are Put Out and Collected

Recycling Grass Clippings and Branch Cuttings

The amount of burnable waste can be reduced by taking grass clippings and branch cuttings (including bamboo), which are generated by households, into the Recycling Center as recyclables (recycled into compost and chips).





How to bring grass clippings and branch cuttings

You'll need to unload your waste yourself. When unloading it, separate grass clippings from branch cuttings, and remove any bindings and bags. Separate them before you bring them, to make unloading easier.

Acceptable size for bringing grass clippings and branch cuttings

The maximum size permitted for branch cuttings is 2 m in length. Remove the soil from the grass clippings as much as possible.

Note

- * Please take grass clippings and branch cuttings to the Recycle Center, as they will not be recycled as resources if they are put out at the waste collection station.
- * Vegetable scraps aren't recyclable, so put them out as burnable waste.
- * Your waste can't be recycled if there are other items mixed in with it, such as empty cans and bottles. Please cooperate by separating your waste thoroughly.
- * Timber can't be put out as branch cuttings.

<Specific examples> Tools (screwdrivers, bars, jacks and hammers), blades and ironware (pots, pans, kettles, carving knives, cooking knives, steel plates, cookers, etc.) and others (dumbbells, scissors and steel furniture)

* Please cover the blades.





Items that may not be put out

- **Contaminated items**
- Items containing a large proportion of different materials
- Fire resistant safes


Hard plastic products that bear no recyclable plastic mark and are about the thickness of a cash card are eligible.

Items that contain materials other than plastic are not eligible. They may be taken in if such different materials are removed.

<Specific examples> Wardrobes, buckets, laundry baskets, clothes hangers, pails, watering cans, bowls, sieves, toys, CD case









Items that may not be put out

- **Contaminated items**
- Items that contain materials other than plastic.
- Items that operate with electricity or batteries are considered small home appliances See p. 9 for details.

♦ CDs, DVDs and **Blu-ray discs**

Furnitures made of wood are eligible. Please remove all other

materials, such as glass, cloth and paper. Nails and screws, however, do not need to be removed.



Large Bulky Items

Large bulky items include the following:

Items that are more than 60 cm in length, width, or height. Items that could cause a fire or explosion, such as kerosene stoves and kerosene fan heaters.





Items may be taken directly to the Chita Nanbu Koiki Kankyo Center (Chita Southern Broad Area Environment Center) charges apply) (The See p. 2 for details.

- Items with any side exceeding 2m in length cannot be processed at the Chita Nanbu Koiki Kankyo Center (Chita Southern Broad Area Environment Center).
- * Please take items that can be recycled as recyclables, such as wooden furniture or bicycles, to the Recycling Center.



Ask a city-authorized waste collection company to take them. (Fees will apply). See p. 19 for details.

The methods and fees for collection and payment will vary depending on the company. Please check with the company you ask.



Ask the city to collect them from your home. (Every Wednesday, by booking only, fees will apply). The fee for collecting one household large bulky item is 2,200 yen.

- (1) Call the person in charge of Waste Reduction at the Environment Section (Phone 23-3567).
- (2) Purchase a "Sodaigomi Shoriken", a large bulky item disposal ticket, at a retailer. No refunds are available for Sodaigomi Shoriken. Please purchase only as many as you need.
- (3) Put the items in front of the entrance at your residence by 8:30 AM on the booked date. You do not need to be present for collection.
- * Our staff will not be able to come into your residence for collections.







New owners, for the unwanted furniture (sofas, beds, shelves, etc.) and bicycles, can be found locally and without paying any fees, by accessing the community information website "Jimoty", managed by the company.

Did it come from a household?

Waste from businesses can't be put out at the waste collection station. Dispose of it via an industrial waste disposal company, etc.

Is it not classified as difficult to dispose of?

The city doesn't handle items that are difficult to dispose of, such as soil, sand, concrete blocks, bricks, and tires. Please contact a specialized disposal company.

Is it not covered by recycling of home appliances?

TVs, air conditioners, refrigerators and freezers, and washing machines and dryers must be disposed of by the designated methods.

 Can it be put out for community recycling collection or as recyclables?

Please cooperate with recycling and reducing waste.

Will it fit into a designated garbage bag?

Things are categorized as large bulky items if they're more than 60 cm in length, width, or height, and the bag can't be tied closed with them in it.

Check the main materials.

If it's made of several materials, break it up as much as possible, then put out the pieces according to their own categories.

If you can't break it up, decide what to do with it based on which material it's mostly made of.
